

Standard & Poor's upgrades DomusVi's credit rating to 'B', highlighting continued improvement in financial indicators and operational performance

Paris, July 15th, 2025 — The credit rating agency Standard & Poor's (S&P Global Ratings) has announced the upgrade of DomusVi's long-term issuer credit rating to 'B'.

This decision reflects strong and sustained improvement in the group's financial metrics and solid business outlook.

The rating upgrade follows a clear recovery in the operating environment for DomusVi, a European leader in senior housing, care, and support services. It also underscores the group's resilience in managing inflationary pressures and ability to rebound from the COVID-19 pandemic.
